Beginning October 2025 Microsoft will no longer support Windows version on current lap top. Lap top has been experiencing issues and been repaired. Considering replacement now or in October. Laptop was purchased in 2018. Trustee Downard suggested a quote from TCR computers. He experienced good service with less unnecessary applications as purchasing from a major box chain.

F550 was struck at Marietta and Holiday roads while cleaning out a ditch. Incident report completed.

Believed to have been a white Ford pickup truck. Damage was to driver's side mirror.

Trustee Ashbaugh opened discussion regarding skim coating and/or paving of some Township Roads beginning in 2025. Jamie from SC Construction offered to present the Board with information regarding

scratch/skim/level coating roads with a cold paving method. Jamie provided information about scratch/skim/level coating the roads. The process would return the "crown" to road and level and put down approximately 1" to 1 ¼ " of cold mix material. For reference he stated that 1 mile of road, 16ft. in width would use anywhere between 500-700 ton of cold patch. He stated for reference a PG6422 material would be used. Jamie also shared that hot mix/asphalt paving would be about 220lb of material per square yard as cold paving would be 150lbs per square yard. He also provided references in Good Hope and Laurel Township. Trustee Ashbaugh shared information he received earlier from McKee paving with estimates. The McKee pricing would be for "Hot"/asphalt paving. Rough estimates for scratch/skim/level coat on a location like Pleasant View were in the 62-63K range per mile. Estimates to straight pave at approximately 2" on a location similar to Heyd road was estimated in the 84-85K range. The Board agreed to consider options and have further discussion at the upcoming meeting in order to select a process and prepare for bids.

Administration

Trustee Downard has received 2 complaints from residents adjacent to Mr. Richard Estep's Starlite auto lot on SR 37. The complaints are related to the re zone of the property which included a modular home that was to be converted to an office for the dealership. Residents expressed concern that the property has returned to a rental property and unrelated to the car lot. Trustee Downard contacted Fairfield County PA office to discuss our options for addressing the matter. Trustee Downard had a phone conversation with the PA office on April 2nd at 2:00 p.m. to review. As a result of the phone conversation, Trustee Downard and the Board agree the rental property is in violation of the agreement made in order for the Re Zone to B1 to occur. Trustee Downard will draft a letter notifying Mr. Estep of the violation for the Board and PA office to review.
